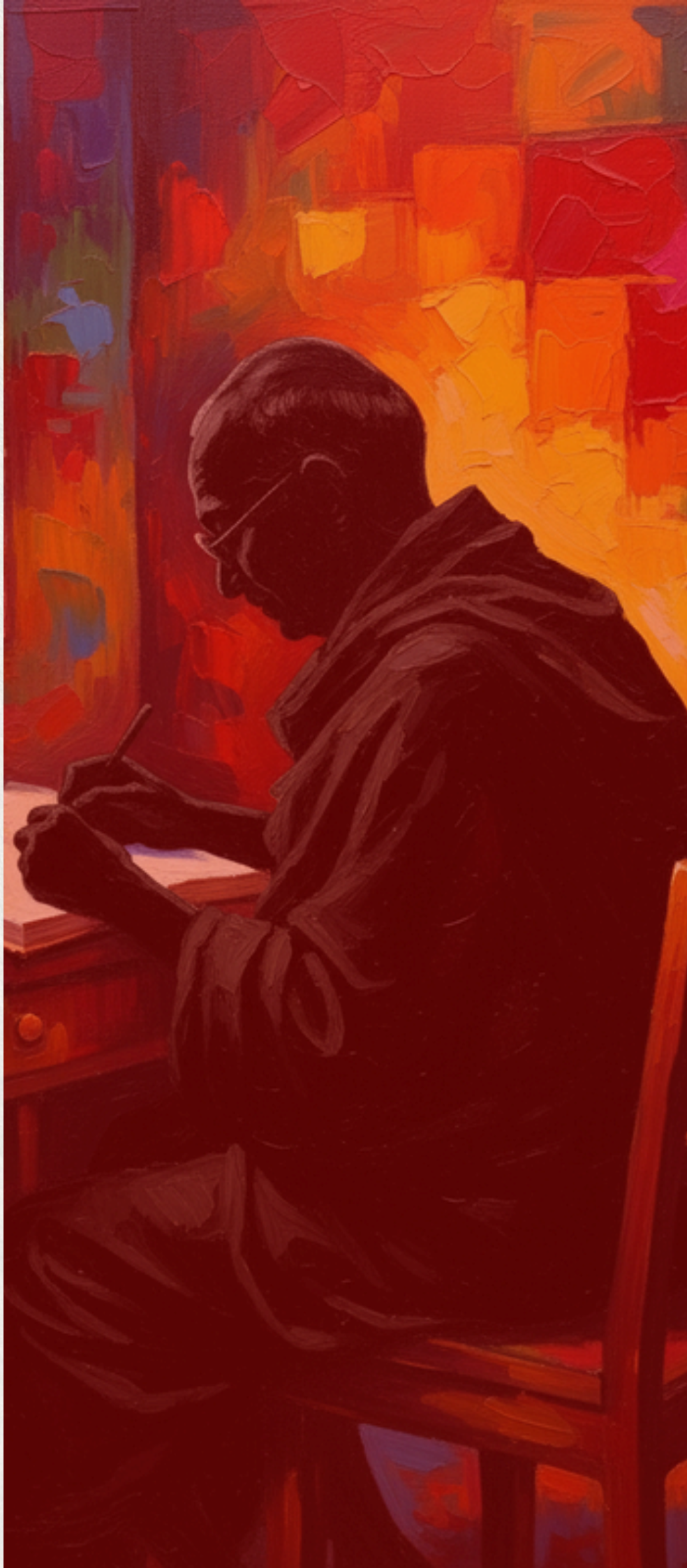

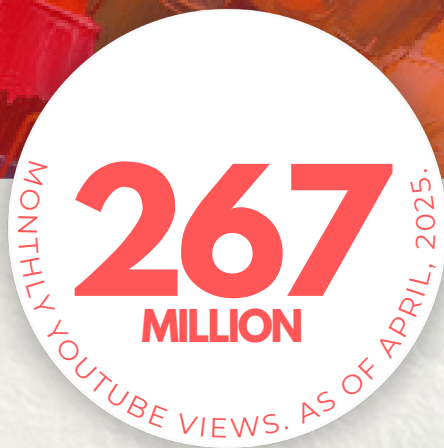

THE LEGACY

NewsX World is the global product of one of India's largest legacy media houses, the iTV Network. The network, founded 25 years ago operates 9 satellite news channels and 5 broadsheet newspapers, with a large online imprint.

THE FOUNDER

Mr. Kartikeya Sharma is an Indian entrepreneur and philanthropist. An independent Member of Parliament of India's upper house (Rajya Sabha). He currently sits on the Parliamentary Committees on Communication & IT, Subordinate Legislation, Rules & Privileges. He's a member of the Indian Council of World Affairs.

An Oxford graduate with an MBA from King's College in London, he also owns and runs three sporting leagues in Wrestling, Boxing and Polo. He's the founder of the NXT Foundation & The NXT Fellowship. Through the Sunday Guardian Foundation, he does philanthropic work in health across the Indian states of Haryana, U.P, Delhi and Maharashtra.



THE CHANNEL

NewsX World is a 24x7 global satellite news channel that is rapidly building its bureaus and presence world-wide. With plans in motion to have 40 reporters across 32 major global capitals on 6 continents, with headquarters in the U.S & India. The channel represents a much-needed news platform emerging from the Indo-Pacific to serve a global audience and a new AI-generation. Bringing the best of old-world legacy news ethics and embracing the latest in technology.

NewsX World is currently broadcasting in English and publishing text & video news in 9 languages, including Spanish, German, Mandarin, Arabic and Italian. A multi-language live telecast is planned to be launched shortly.

NewsX World will be a satellite news channel that not only has a large social media presence, but is also available on more than 1,200 global OTT platforms and all major connected TV brands. It's leveraging a \$ 100 million dollar investment made into the news ecosystem by the network and expanding that globally with additional capital. It boasts of more than 40,000 square feet of state-of-the-art studio & newsroom space built-out at it's Media House in New Delhi and at BKC, Mumbai. Plans are in place for broadcasting studios in the U.S, Europe, Africa & the Middle East.

THE LAUNCH

NewsX World was launched at a grand ceremony in New Delhi by the **Prime Minister of India, Hon. Narendra Modi, on March 1, 2025**. The launch ceremony was attended by Hon. Tony Abbott, Former Prime Minister of Australia, Rt. Hon. Stephen J. Harper, Former Prime Minister of Canada and Mr. Ranil Wickremesinghe, the Former President of Sri Lanka.

83 Dignitaries from 17 nations were also present including Members of Parliament, academicians, journalists, scholars, entrepreneurs and business leaders at an event attended by more than 2,000 people across two days.

THE EDITORIAL

NewsX World is being built from the ground-up to present fair and balanced news and views, with multiple-perspectives from across the globe. The channel's philosophy under 'truth persists' looks to offer current affairs information in a world that requires credibility and gravitas as a global audience gets inundated with over-information, misinformation and disinformation. The channel's reporting and editorial staff is being structured to represent the broadest range of nationalities and ethnicities to represent the widest possible range of experiences and knowledge.

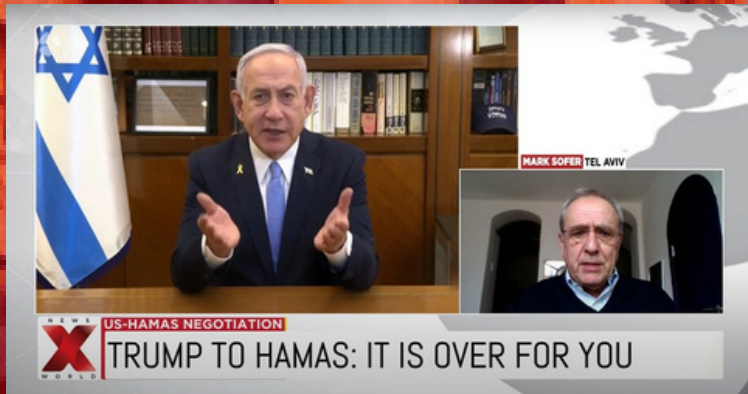
